




1. Right stick

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
Always hold controller with both hands and wear the wriststrap

Press down on lever to remove stock
















**Approximate sensor bar range: 3.5 m / 11.5 ft**

- LED light turns red when sensor bar is on
- LED will flash when sensor bar is about to turn off OR has low battery
- Press power/reset button for 1 second to turn off sensor bar
