## Water to use in your iron ?

Your iron has been designed to be used with tap water. However, the self-cleaning feature has to be used regularly to eliminate any mineral build-up the steam chamber. If your water is very hard (check with your Local Environmental Services or water company), you can use a mix of half tap water and half distilled water. Do not use any other types of water nineral build-up in

# **3- CARING FOR YOUR IRON**

## CLEANING THE SOLEPLATE

· When the soleplate is cool, clean with a damp, non-metal washing up pad We recommend that

when using starch, it should be sprayed onto the reverse side of the fabric and the soleplate cleaned more frequently.

Be careful! Unplug your iron and let it cool down before cleaning.
Do not use detergent or descaling products.
Never put the iron under the tap.

CLEAN THE ANTI-CALC VALVE (at least once every 2 months)



onto DRY (18 ) · To remove the anti-calc valve, pull upwards by means of the grips located on either side. • Leave to soak in white vinegar or pure lemon juice for around 2 hours. Rinse under the tap

· Empty the iron and put the ironing control

· Replace and slot down into the housing

Be careful! the iron only works if the anti-calc valve is in place

■ SELF-CLEANING (twice a month)


· Fill the tank to the MAX mark (see our recommendations on the type of water to use)

• Put the thermostat control on MAX and the steam control on DRY (喻) and switch on. (1)

· Place the iron on its heel and wait around 5 minutes

- Unplug the iron and place over the sink horizontally.
- · Completly remove the anti-calc valve.
- · Shake the iron gently until all the water (and any impurities) has drained from the soleplate. 2


Replace the anti-calc valve.
 When the soleplate is just warm, wipe the iron with a soft cloth.





■ SETTING THE TEMPERATURE AND STEAM LEVEL Place the thermostat control to match the type of fabric to be ironed.



The light comes on. Wait for the light to go off and come on again before you start ironing

#### We recommend that you

 Start with the fabrics to be ironed on a low temperature (•) and finish with those which respond best to higher temperatures (••• or MAX) - If you lower the thermostat, wait until the light comes on again before

If you iron a fabric made of a blend of fibres: set the temperature fo the most fragile fibre.

Be careful! Your iron will only produce steam when the thermostat control is in the coloured zone.


