GETTING STARTED

BATTERY INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the
- Install 2 new 'AAA' (AM-4/LR03) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance.)




BATTERY NOTICE

- · Use new alkaline batteries for maximum performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbonzinc) or rechargeable (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH), or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- · Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- · Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- · Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- · Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable)

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. ON/OFF/VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH

To turn the unit ON, slide the ON/OFF/VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH to the LOW VOLUME ()) or HIGH VOLUME ()) position. To turn the unit OFF, slide the ON/OFF/VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH to the OFF () position.



2. AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

To preserve battery life, the VTech® Tiny Touch™ Tablet will automatically power-down after approximately 60 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button. Rolling the roller ball will not turn the unit back on.

ACTIVITIES


 Slide the on/off/volume control switch to turn the unit on. You will hear a singalong song and a playful phrase. The lights will flash with the sound.

Press the calendar button to learn numbers and days of the week. The lights will flash with the sound.




 Press the ABC button to learn letters and hear the Alphabet Song. The lights will flash with the sound.
